Pirate	A person who attacks and robs ships at sea.
Mast	Is used to support the sails and is usually found in the middle of the ship
Galley	An area of the ship where food is prepared
Port Hole	A small window on the outside of the ship
Crows Nest	The lookout point of the mast
Sail	A piece of fabric that catches the wind to power the ship
Float	Where an object sits on the water
Sink	Where an object falls below the surface of the water
Similarities	Where something is almost the same as something else
Difference	Where something is not like something else
