We are very proud of our school and of our pupils and we believe that high standards of uniform, behaviour and attendance give each and every one of our pupils the very best opportunity to learn and achieve their full potential.

As well as enjoying the summer break with your children, you will no doubt be thinking ahead to the annual trip to the shops to source uniform and school shoes. Before any of you embark on this, please could we take this opportunity to remind you of some key parts our uniform policy. Please refer to the information below. The intention of this is to avoid unnecessary confusion at the start of term with pupils returning to school in September not dressed in accordance with our school uniform policy.

Lincoln Gardens Primary School Uniform Checklist

Girls

Skirt: Dark grey knee-length skirt, pinafore or trousers
Shirt: White or pale blue polo shirt or plain white shirt/blouse
Cardigan: Royal blue (with school logo is available)
Optional fleece: Royal blue with the school logo
Shoes: Sensible, flat heeled, black shoes with white, grey or black socks or grey or black tights. No open-toe shoes, sandals, trainers or boots

Summer wear

Pale blue checked summer dress or plain dark grey shorts may be substituted if preferred

Boys

Trousers: Dark grey trousers
Shirt: White or pale blue polo shirt or plain white shirt
Sweatshirt: Royal blue (with school logo is available)
Optional fleece: Royal blue with the school logo
Shoes: Sensible, black shoes with black or grey socks
 No trainers or boots

Summer wear

Plain, dark grey smart shorts may be substituted for trousers if preferred



PE Kit

Plain white round necked T-shirt

Plain black shorts

Black plimsolls (or predominately black) plain trainers

Optional black sweatshirt and joggers for outdoor PE

A draw string bag to hold all PE items in

All jewellery must be removed on PE days

Pupils with long hair are expected to tie it back for PE as it can be dangerous on gym apparatus and during games lessons

We do not permit children to have extreme haircuts that could serve as a distraction to other children and are not in keeping with the ethos of the school. This includes patterns shaved into the hair, excessive use of hair products, false and extreme hair colours.

Jewellery

No jewellery is permitted, with the exception of a wristwatch (no smart watches) and one pair of small studded earrings.

All children will require a freshly filled water bottle (containing just water) to be brought to school daily. We also recommend that you purchase a book bag from the school office so that all reading items can be placed in this.

In order to avoid confusion and to keep lost property to a minimum all items of clothing, P.E. kit, bags etc, must be clearly labelled with the child's name.
