Definitions.

A red flower symbolic of the blood shed during the war.

A period of fighting between states or nations.

An empty tomb or a monument erected in honour of a person or group of people whose remains are elsewhere.

An arrangement of flowers, leaves, or stems fastened in a ring and used for decoration or for laying on a grave:

A state or period in which there is no war or a war has ended:

A type of structure that was explicitly created to commemorate a person or event, or which has become relevant to a social group as a part of their remembrance of historic times or cultural heritage.

The act of remembering something that has previously happened.
