Explorer	Someone who goes on a journey to find out about somewhere or something new.
Jungle	An area of land overgrown with dense forest and tangled vegetation.
Mountain	A large natural elevation of the earth's surface rising abruptly from the surrounding ground.
Ocean	A very large expanse of sea.
Vehicles	Things used to transport people or goods.
Desert	A waterless, desolate area of land with little or no vegetation, typically one covered with sand.
Space	The universe beyond the Earth's atmosphere.
Planet	A celestial body moving in orbit round a star.
Similarities	Where something is almost the same as something else.
Difference	Where something is not like something else.

I know what an explorer is and name some significant explorers from history.
