Parent Pay

Lincoln Gardens is now a cashless school; payments for all items including school lunches, trips and breakfast clubs should be made via the ParentPay website.

This is a simple and secure way for parents, guardians and carers to make trusted cashless payments and efficiently manage school purchases.

At ParentPay you will have access to your account and are able to manage your payments.

From September 5 2022 the school will only accept payments via ParentPay for school-related purchases; however, there may be occasions when cash is requested for certain types of events such as fundraising days and third party payments.

Parents/carers are required to activate their ParentPay account to ensure all communication is received and consents can be given.
