Eastings	Eastward measured distance or the x co-ordinate.

Explain why the steelworks was located in Scunthorpe. The steelworks was located in Scunthorpe due to the discovery of iron ore to the East of Scunthorpe and the easy access to the River Trent to initially move the Iron then the steel. Additionally huge amounts of water are required for steel manufacture which also came from the River Trent.

In the beginning Scunthorpe relied on trade because they were a huge manufacturer and exporter of steel. There were other manufacturers in the area who also relied on the production of steel. Many of the people in Scunthorpe worked at the steelworks and the other manufacturers in the area, meaning that their family income came from trade. Shops and restaurants in the area also relied on the families spending their money in the local area, which they were paid through their steel working jobs.
